WHAT'S NEW

- Men's and women's lacrosse begin their inaugural seasons as varsity sports in fall 2021 at Mohr Field, our new turf facility.
- The renovation and expansion of Brown Hall was completed. It is the most historic academic building on campus and new home to the Gorter Family Career Advancement Center.
- Our new Oppenheimer Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation, a space where students and faculty can create and collaborate on new ventures, opened in fall 2021.

DISTINCTIVE ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

- Our new Health Professions Program is a unique partnership with Rosalind Franklin University of Medicine and Science, allowing students direct pathways to numerous popular health careers.
- The African American Studies Program was elevated to full department status in spring 2021 in response to great student interest.
- Entrepreneurship and innovation is the most popular minor at the College.
- We offer majors in both finance and business, which are not available at many liberal arts colleges.
- Our self-designed major enables students to work with a faculty advisor to design a major suited to their academic interests.
- The Richter Scholar Program offers one-on-one research opportunities with a professor during the summer after the student's first year.

INTERNSHIPS AND CAREER PREPARATION

- 98% of our graduates get jobs or continue their education within six to nine months of graduation.
- Students are supported through a unique career pathway model that matches students' interests with possible career paths. Career Advancement Center staff begin working with students during their first year.
- Students may complete up to three for-credit internships.
- Internships are abundant in the Chicago area. Our students also secure internships in major cities around the country and the world.
- Through the Lake Forest In The Loop and ACTIVATE programs, students can live in Chicago completing internships and taking courses.
