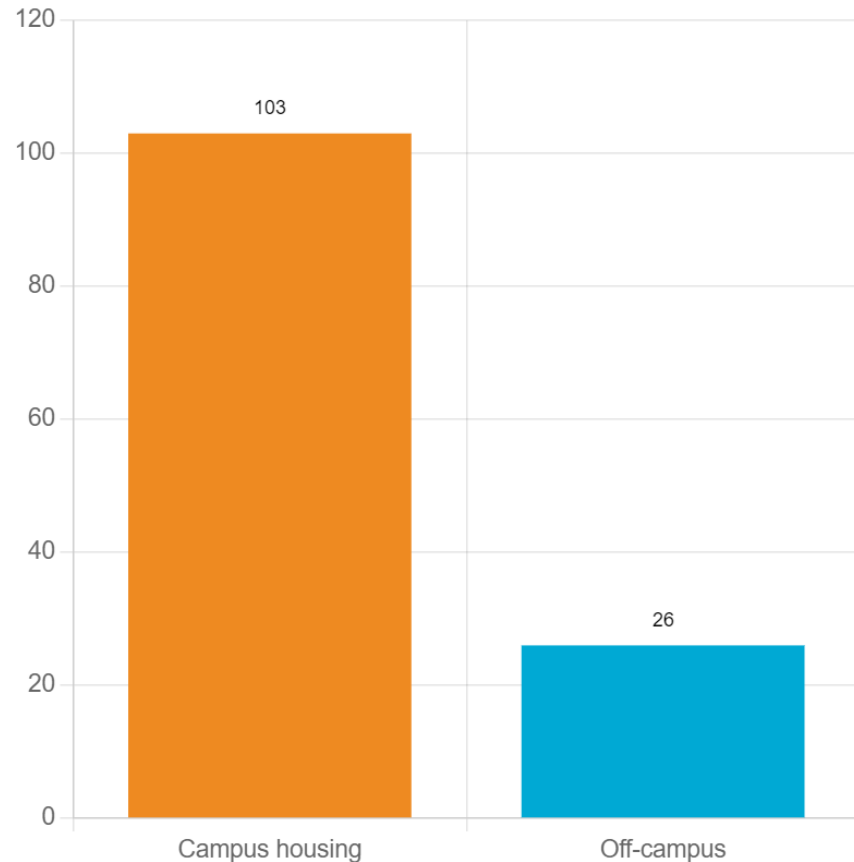
How many years have you been at the college?

Where are you living while attending Lake Forest College?



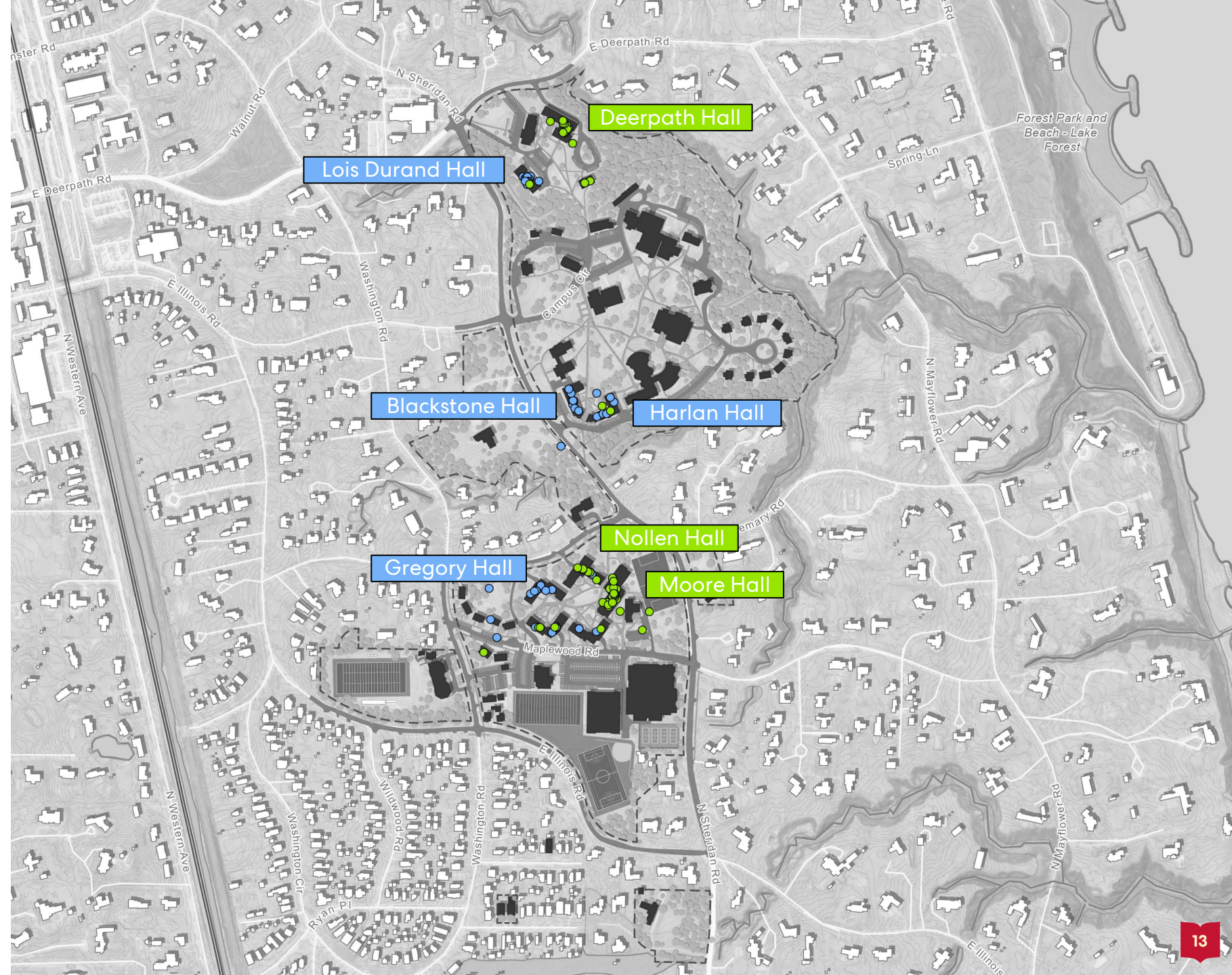

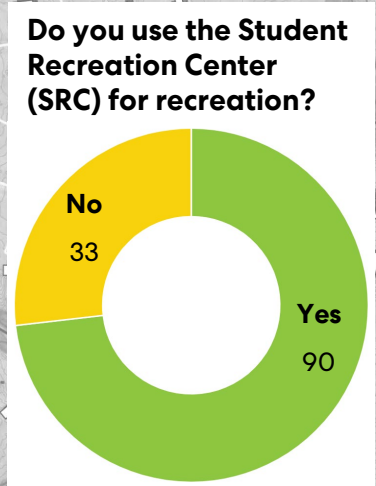

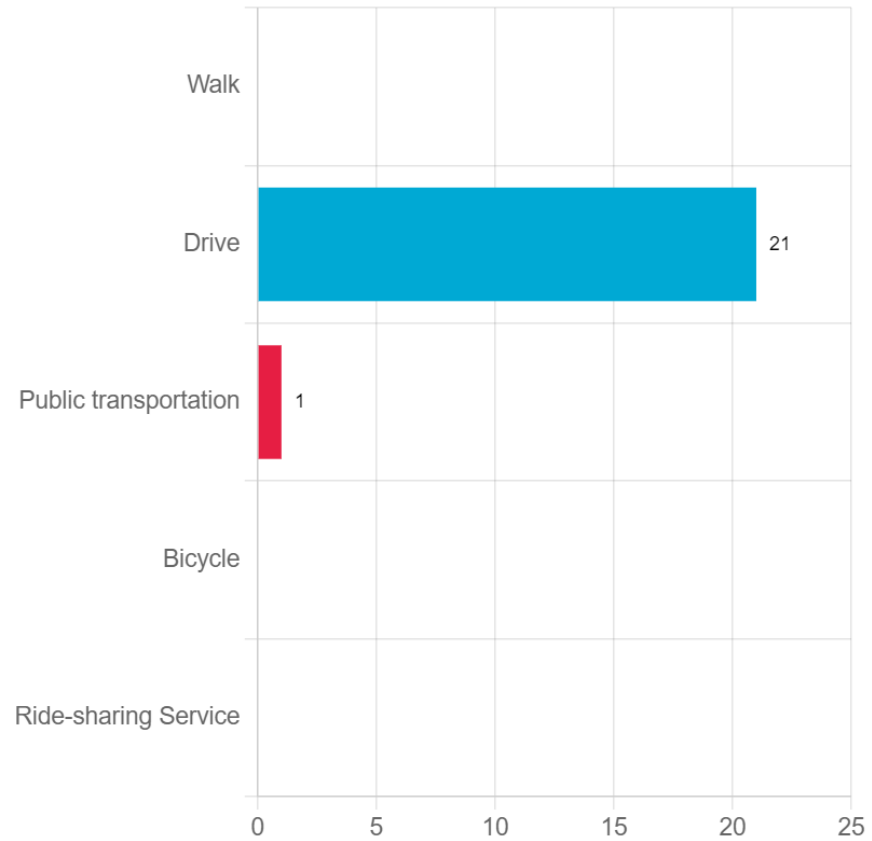

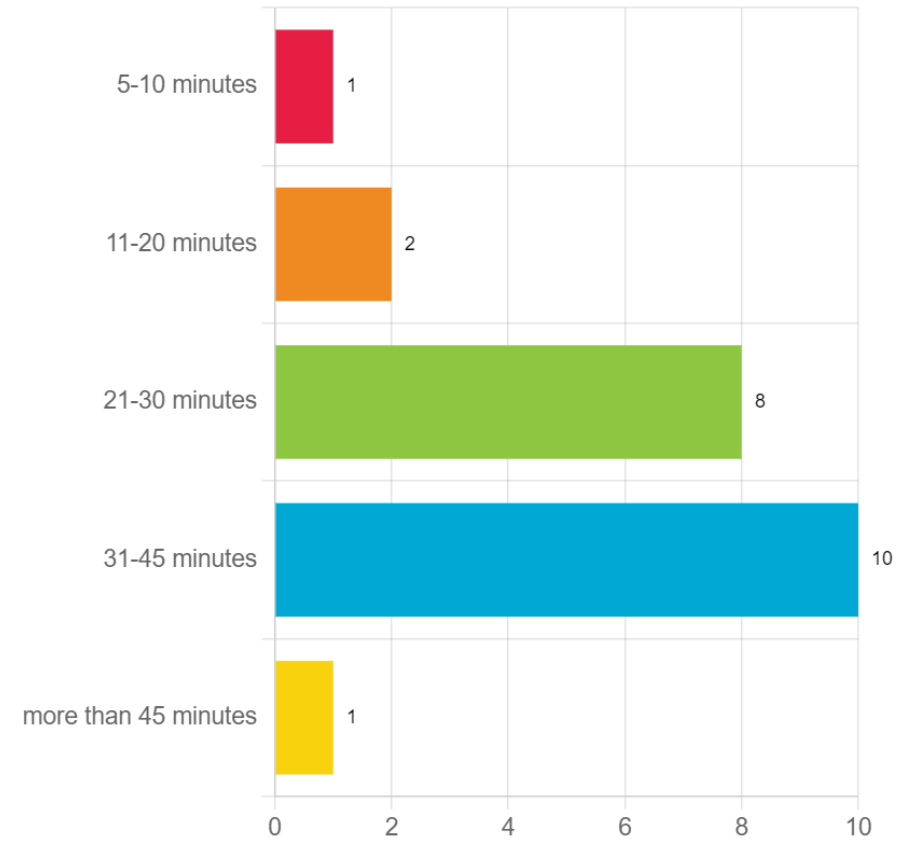

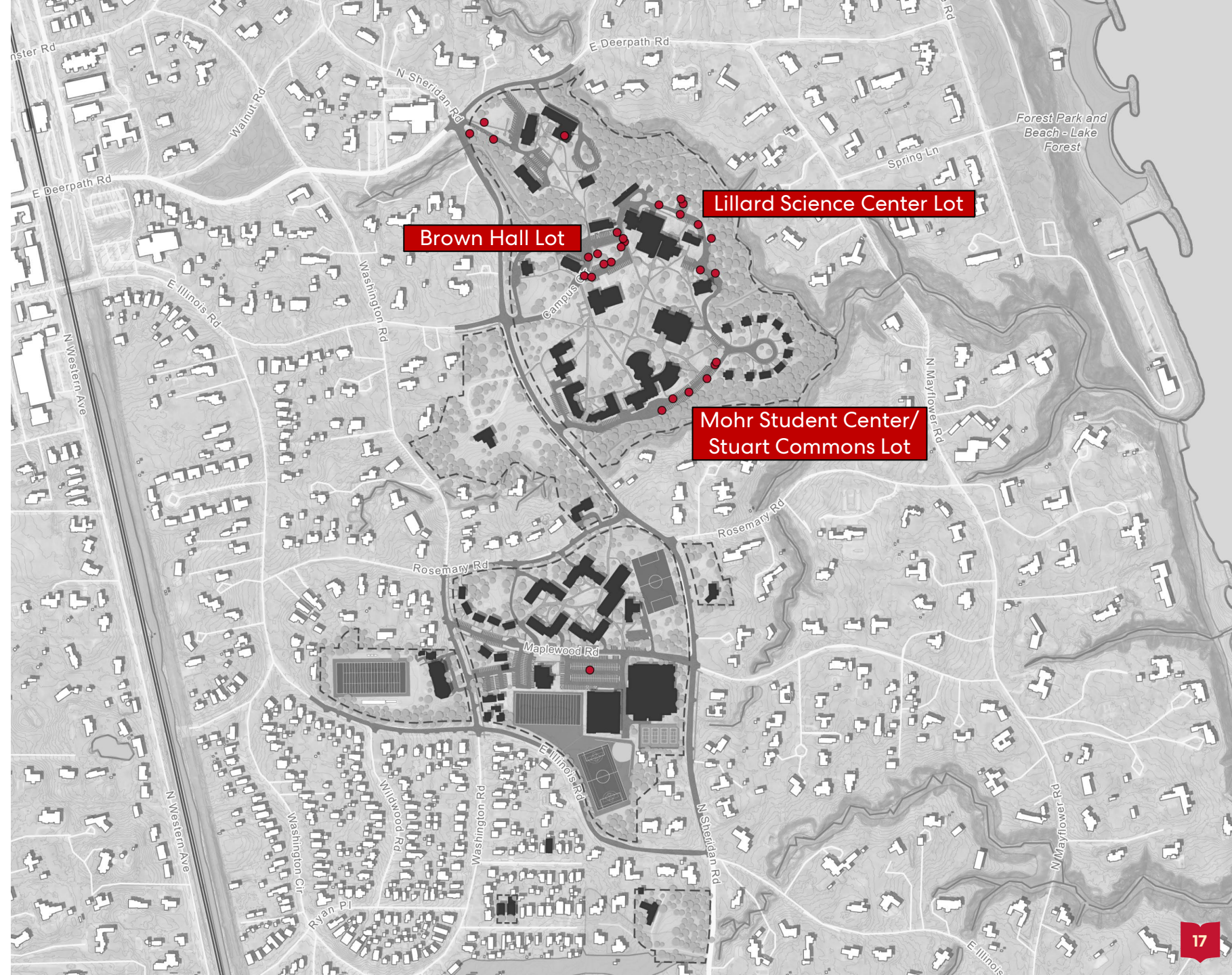
How do you typically commute to campus?

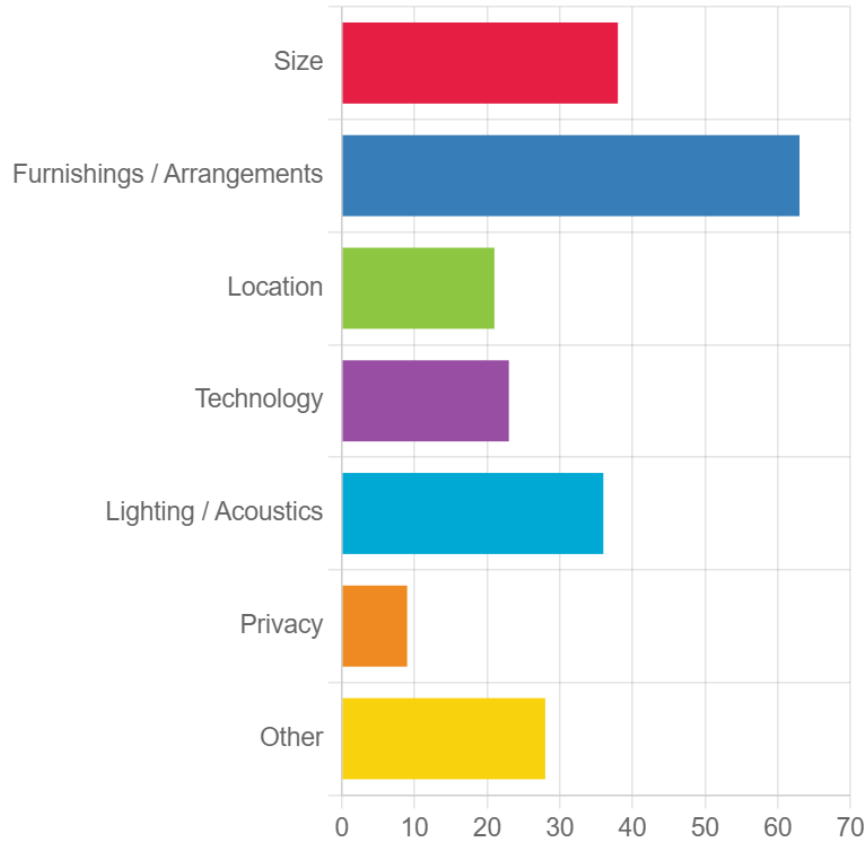

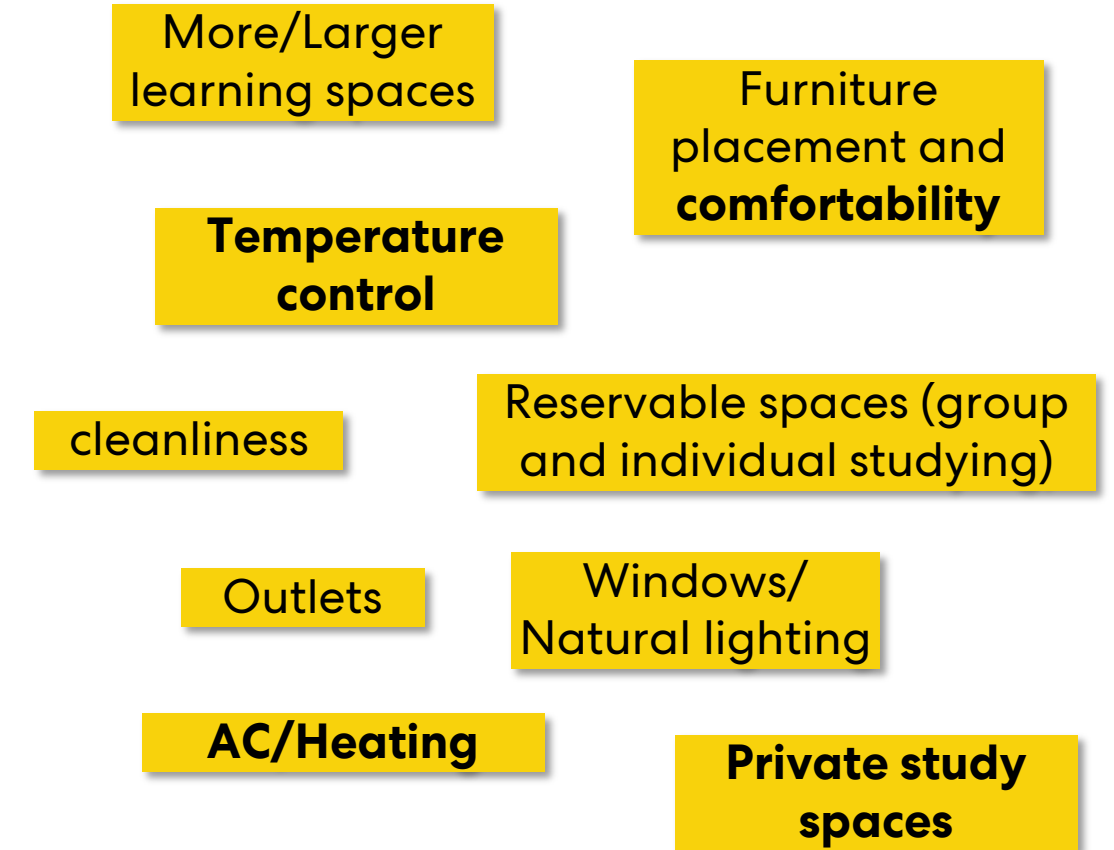

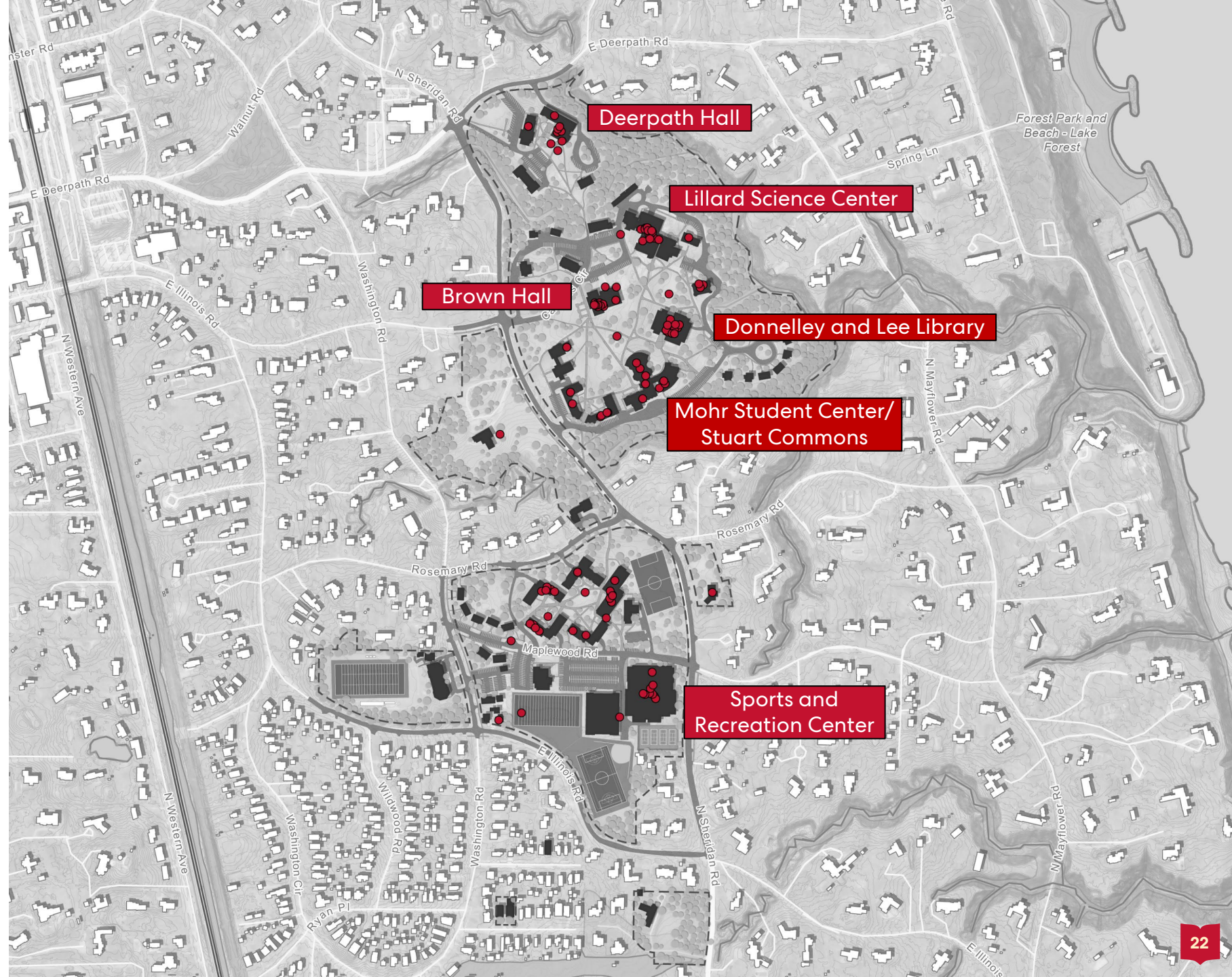

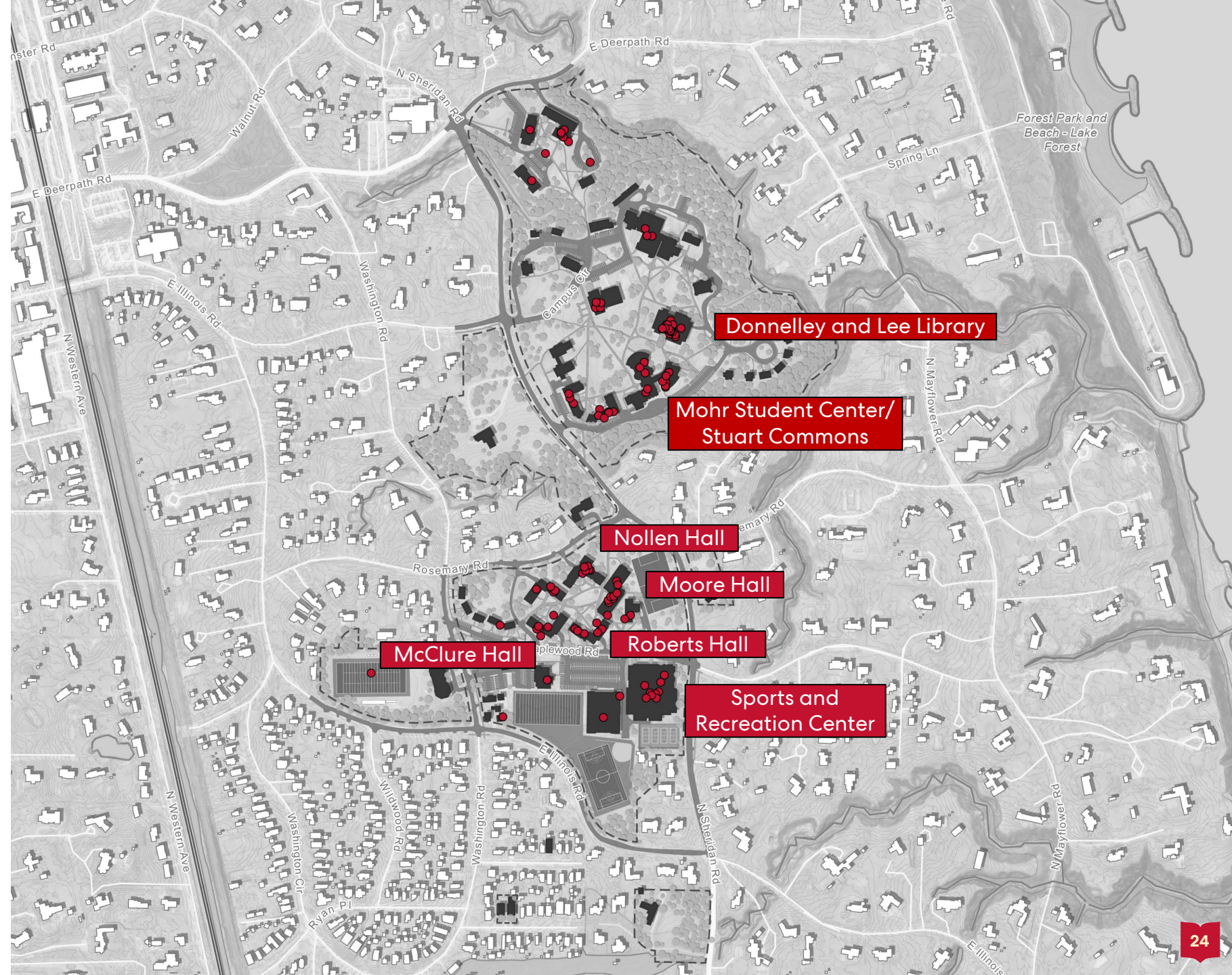

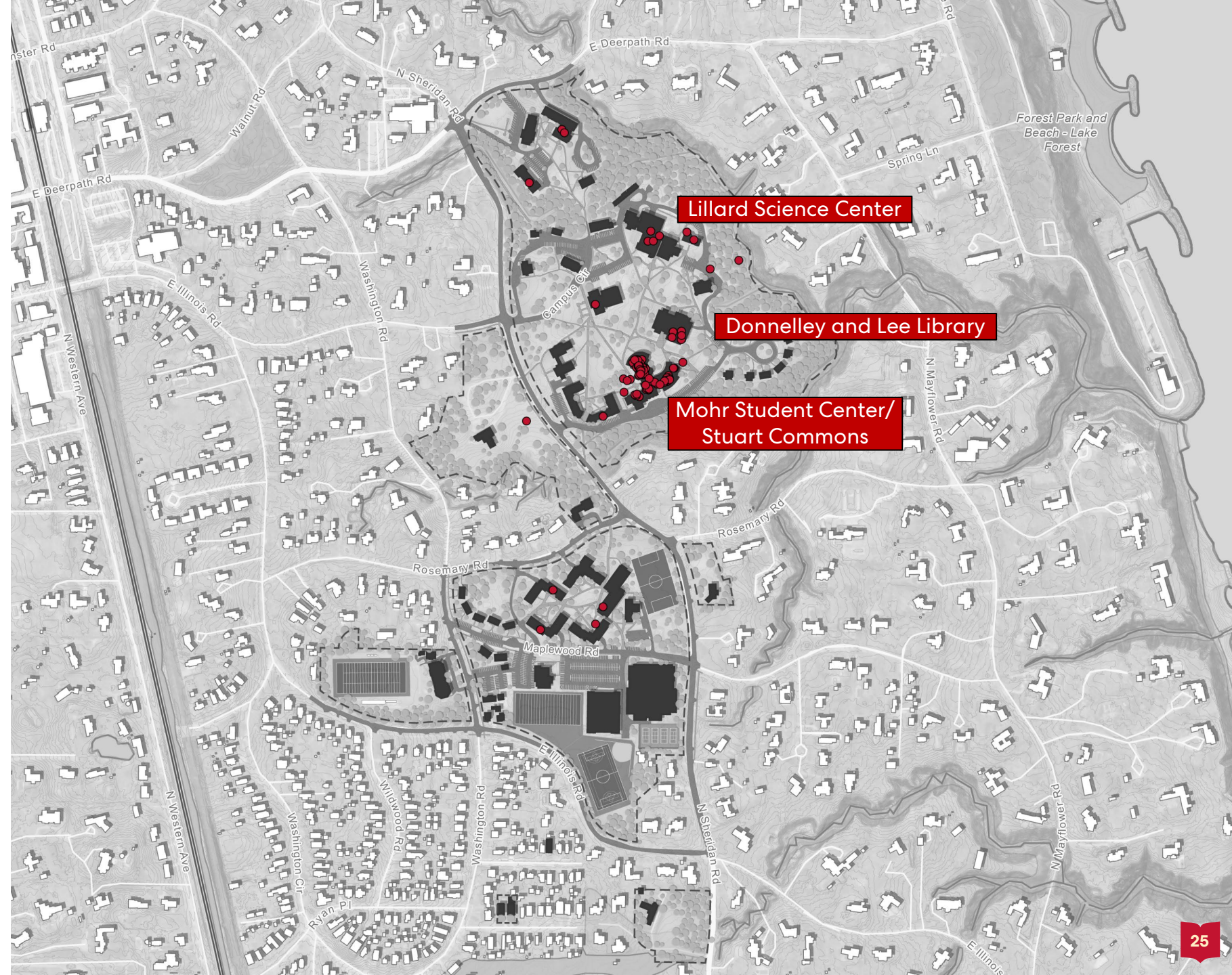

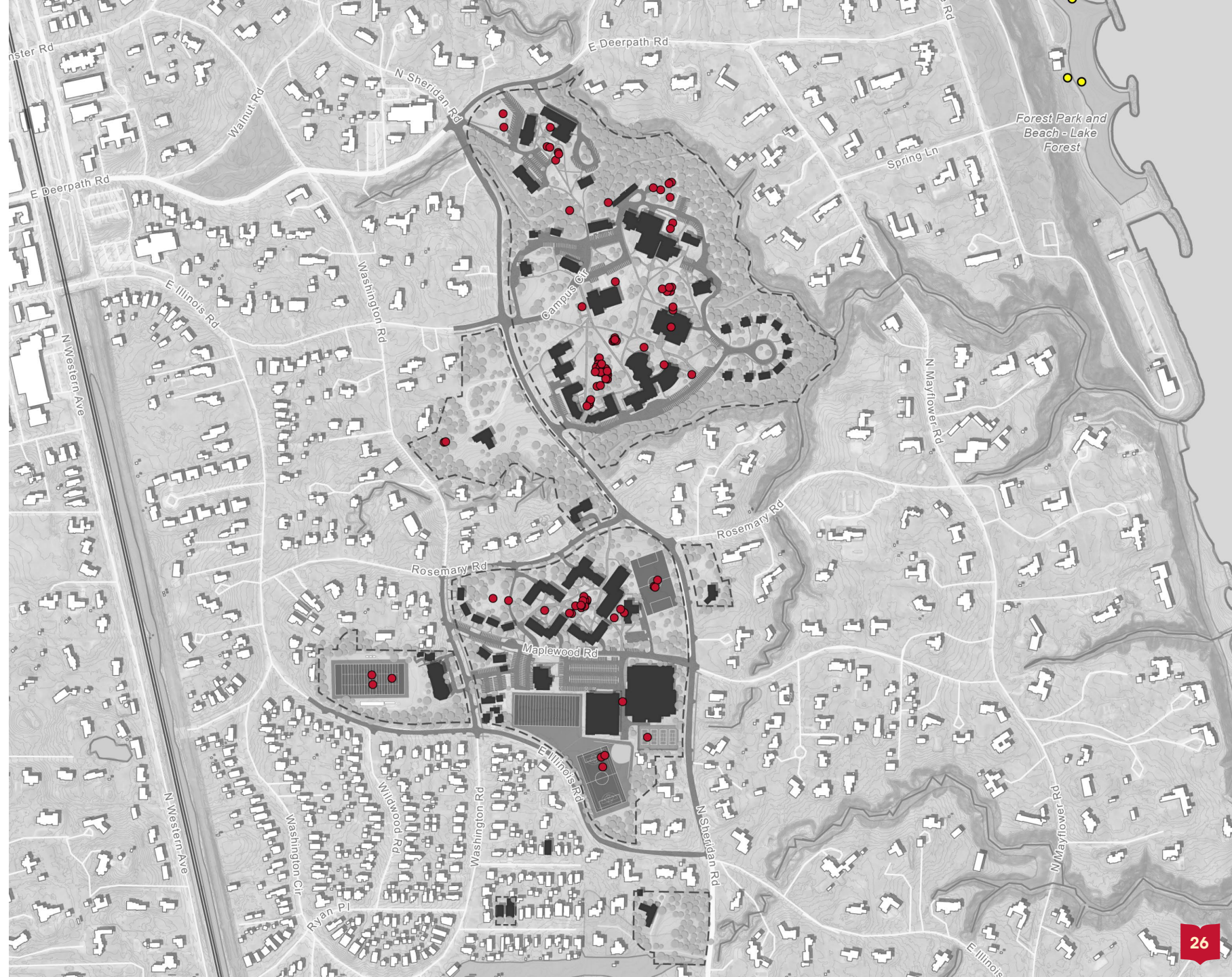

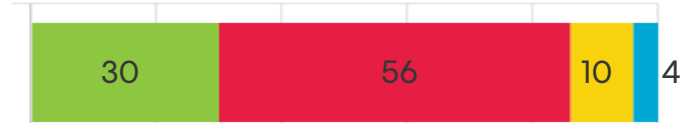

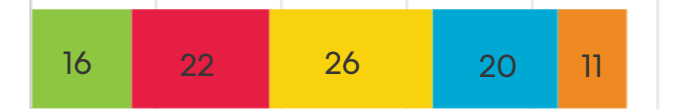

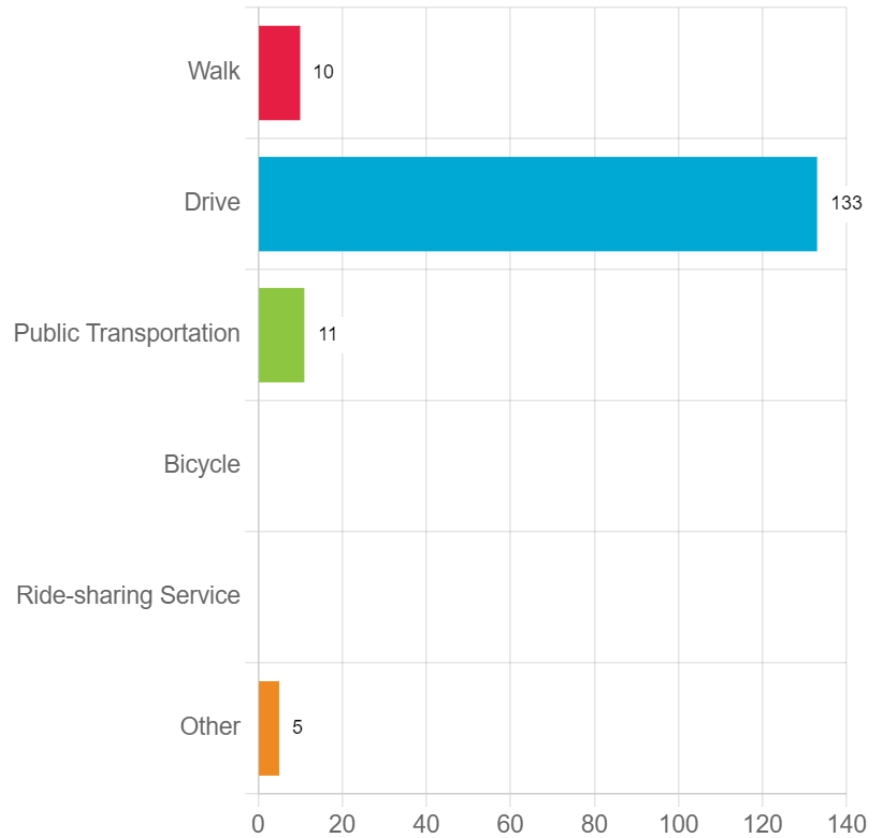

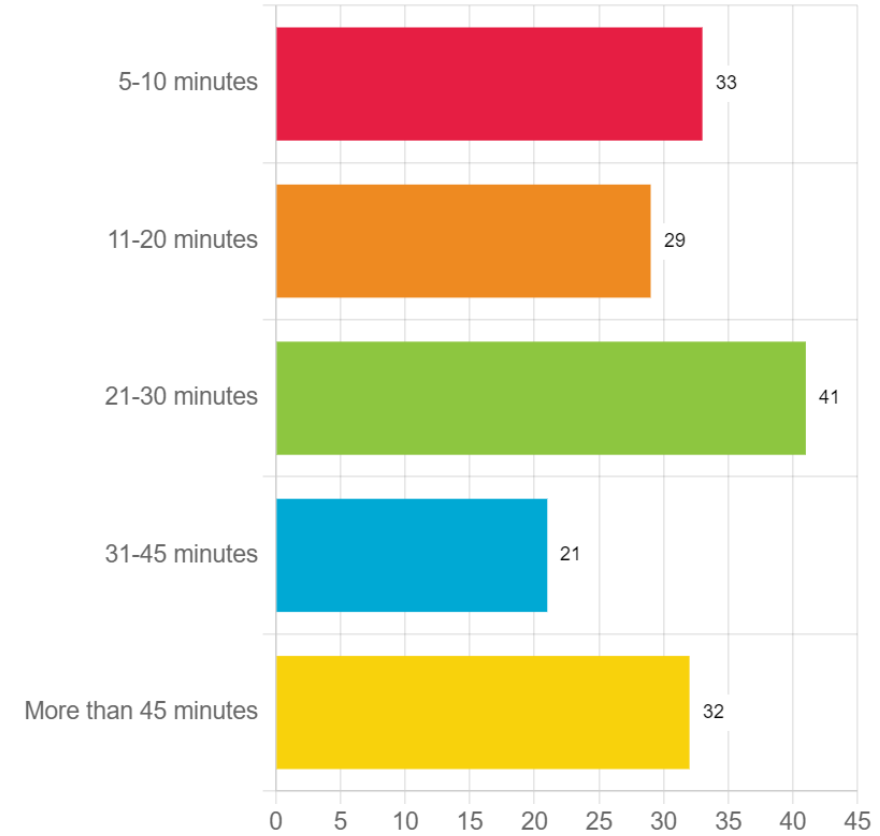

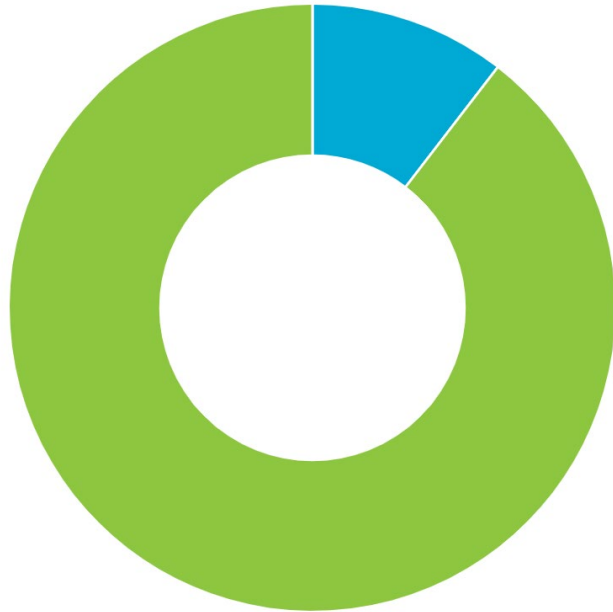

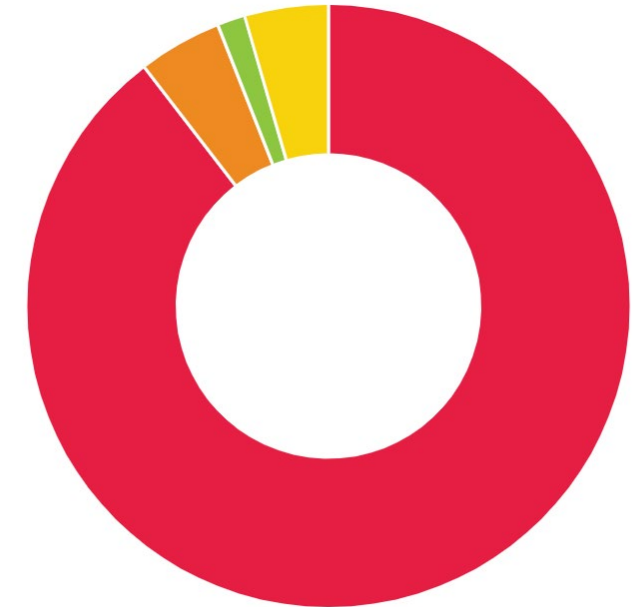

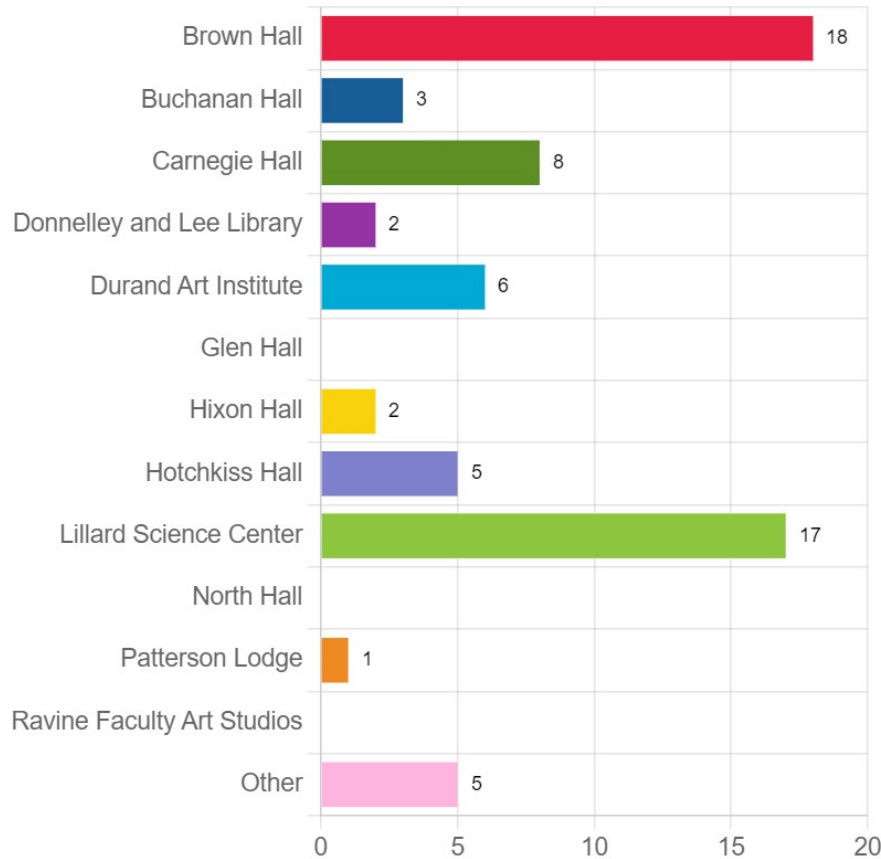

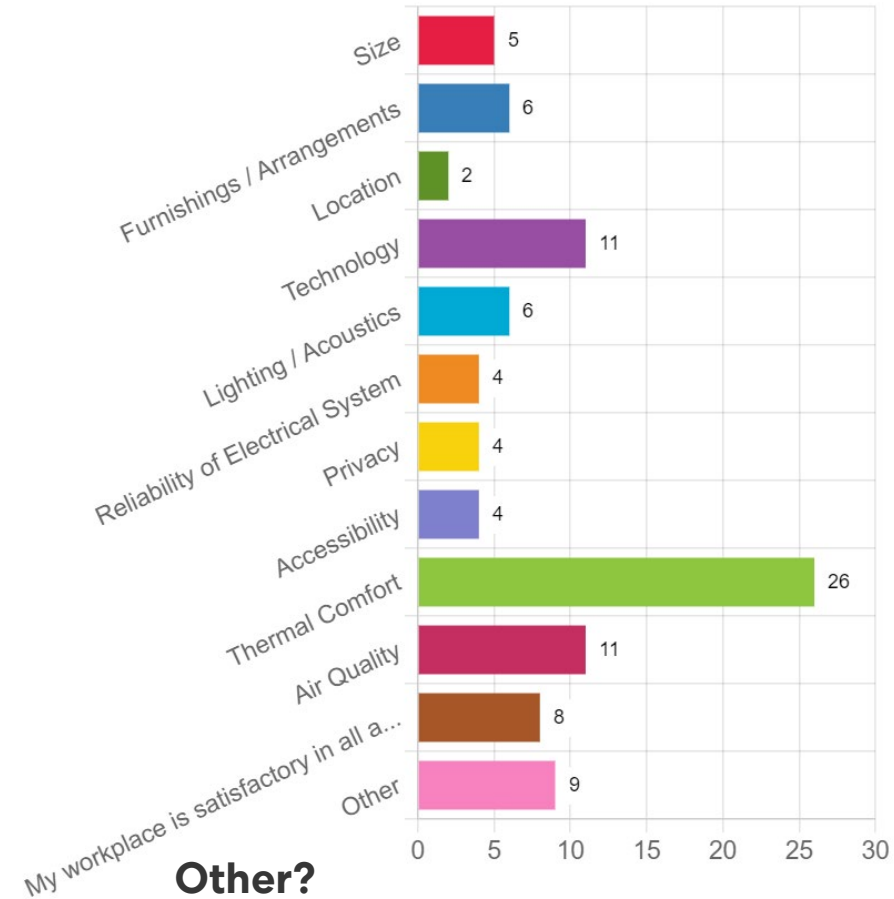

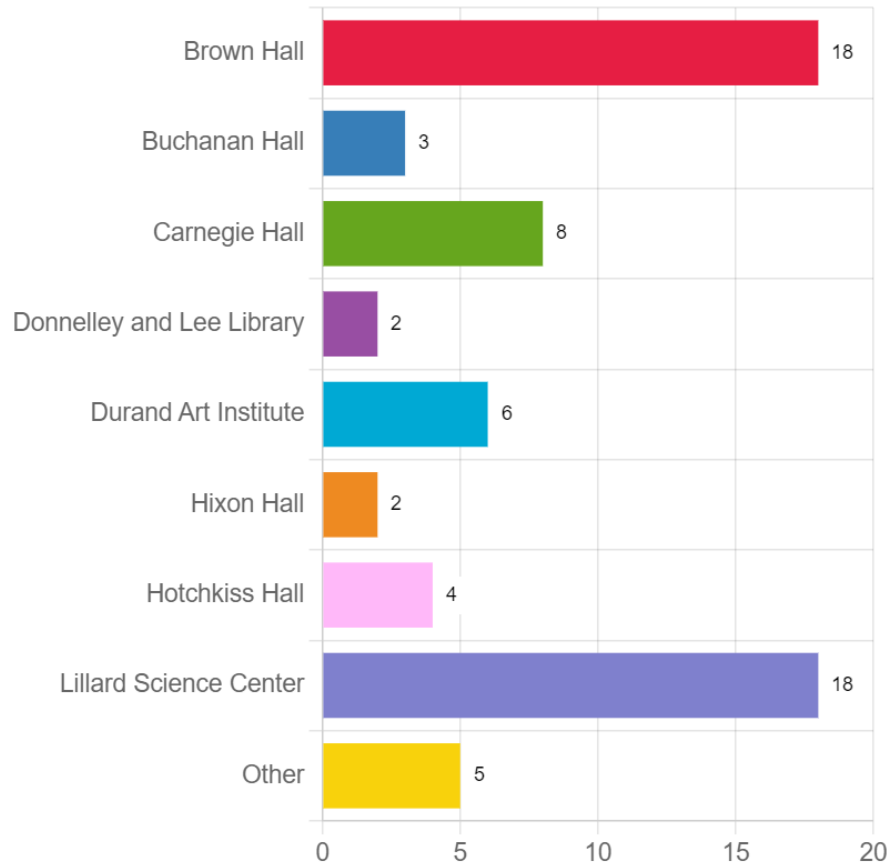

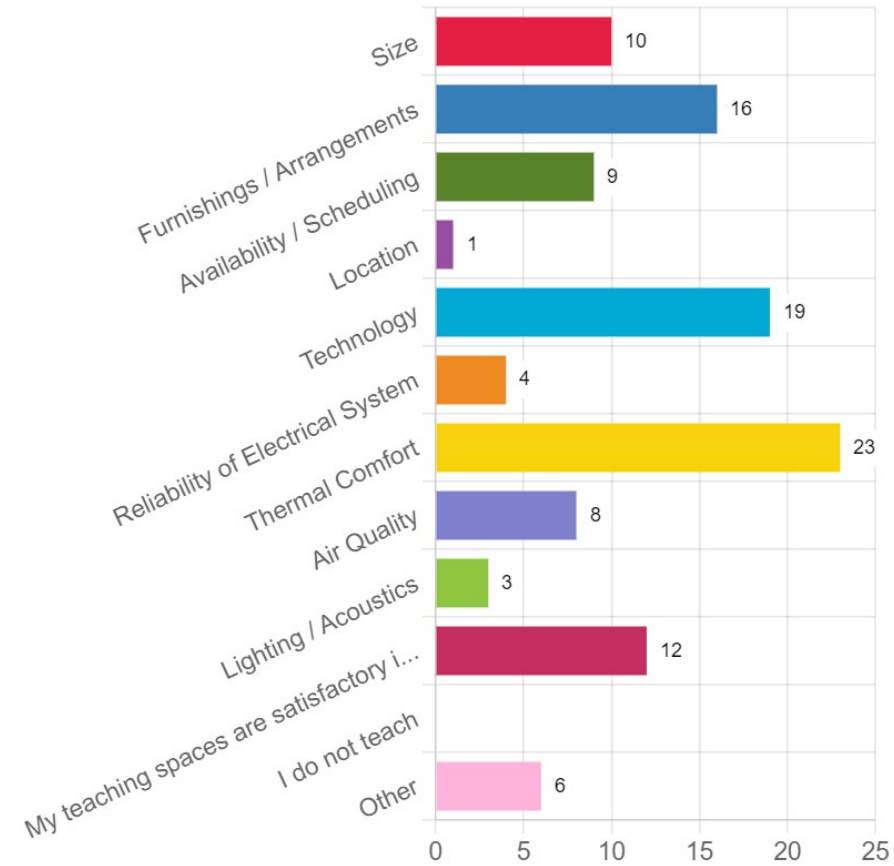

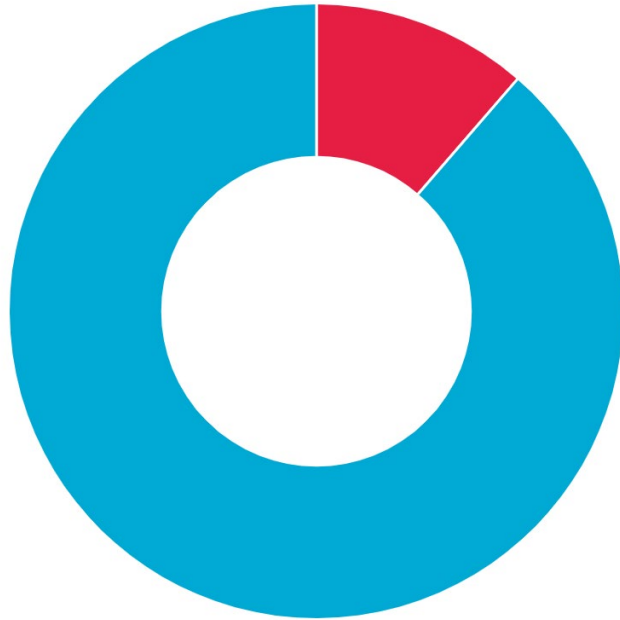

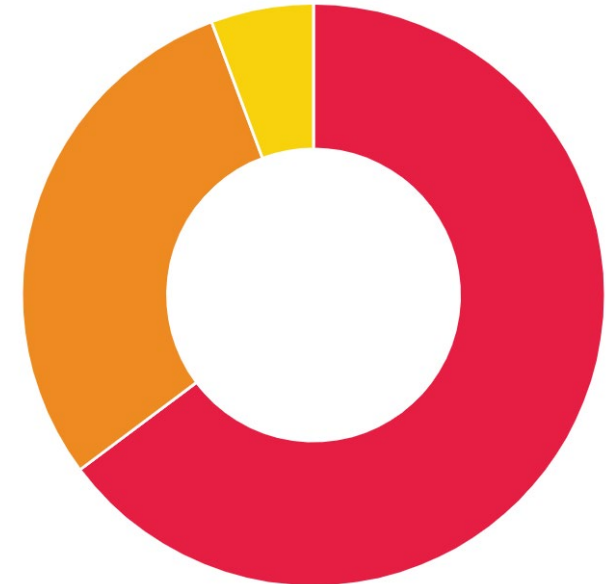

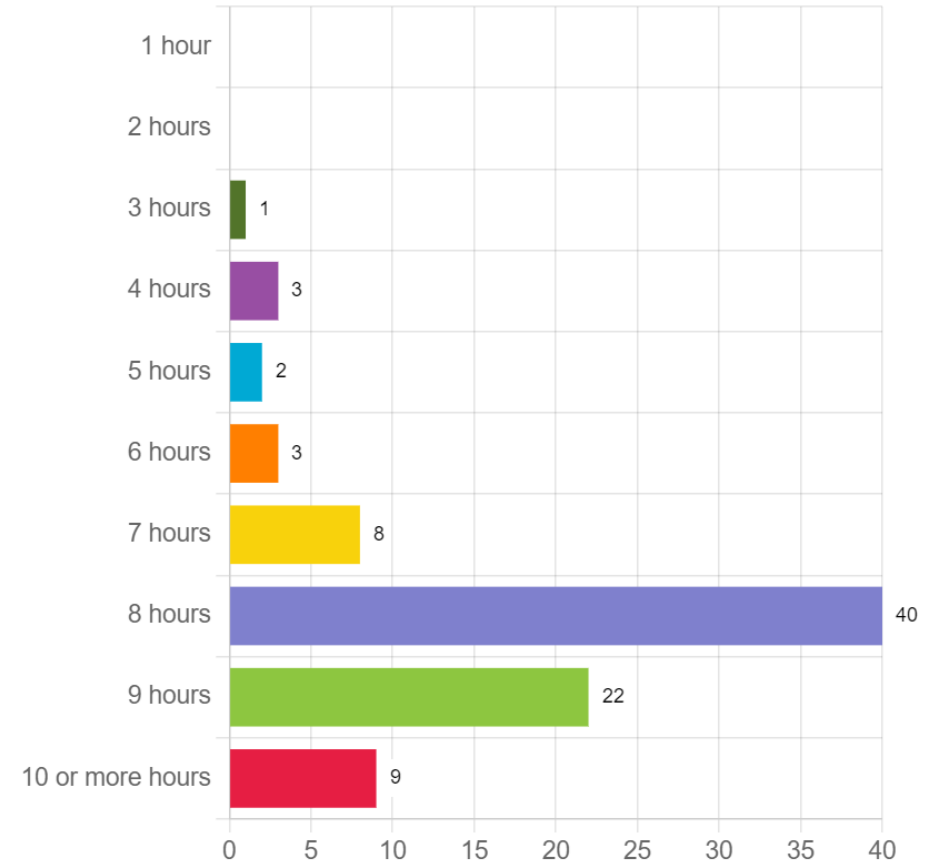

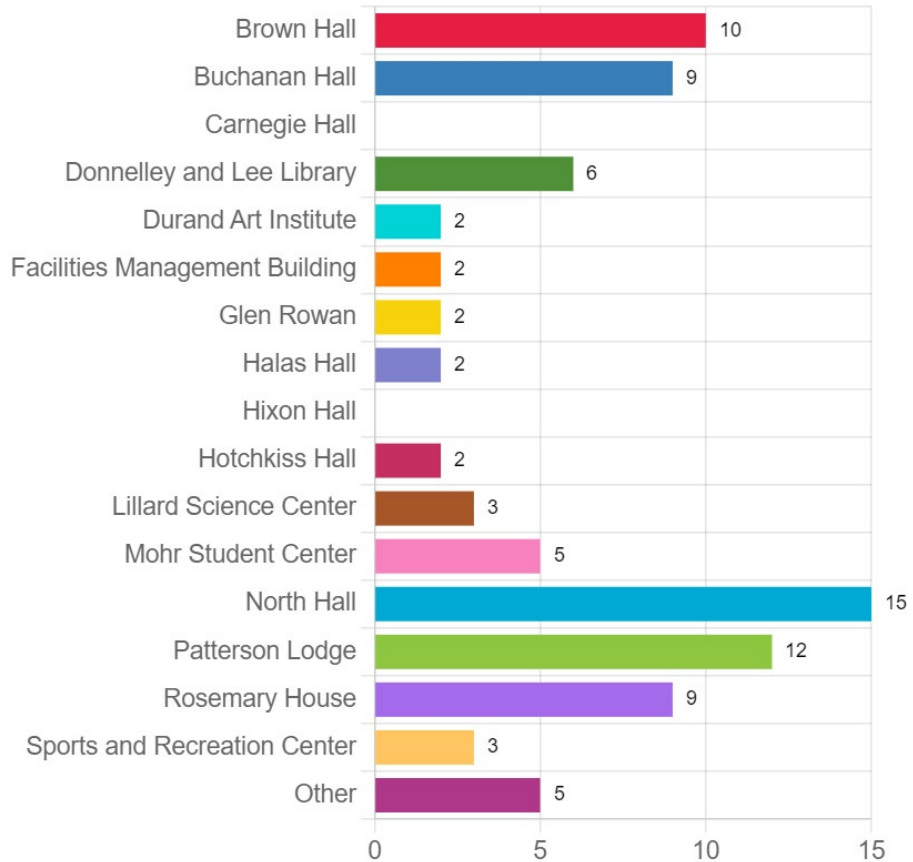
How many days a week do you typically spend on campus?

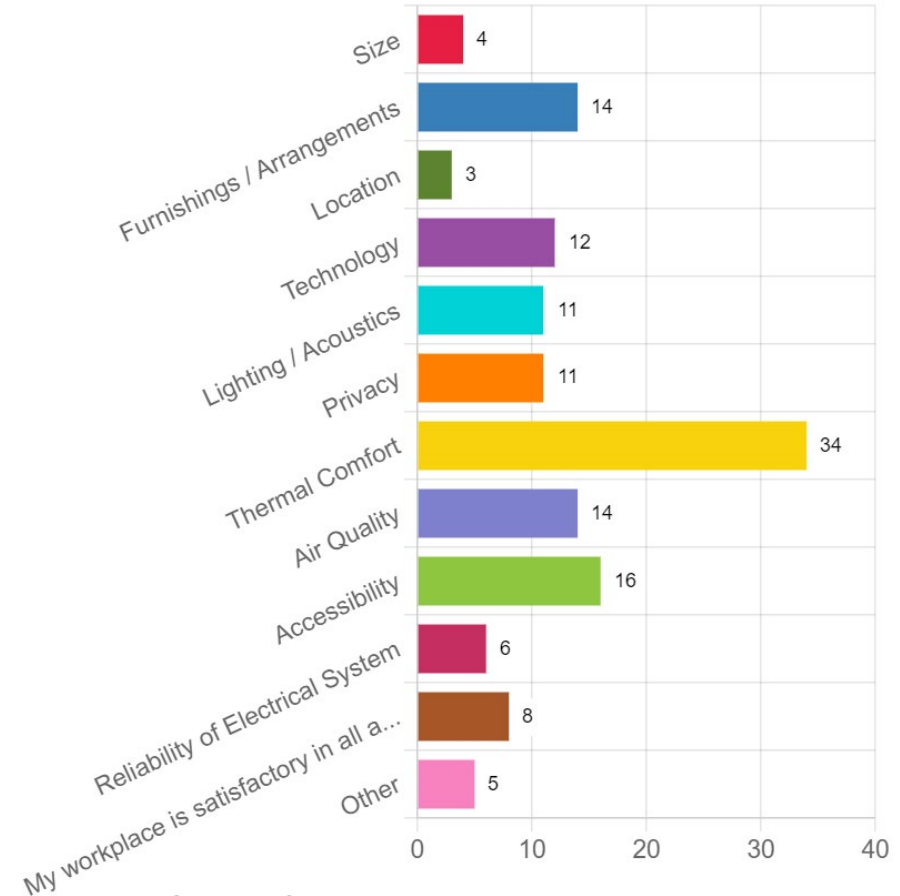

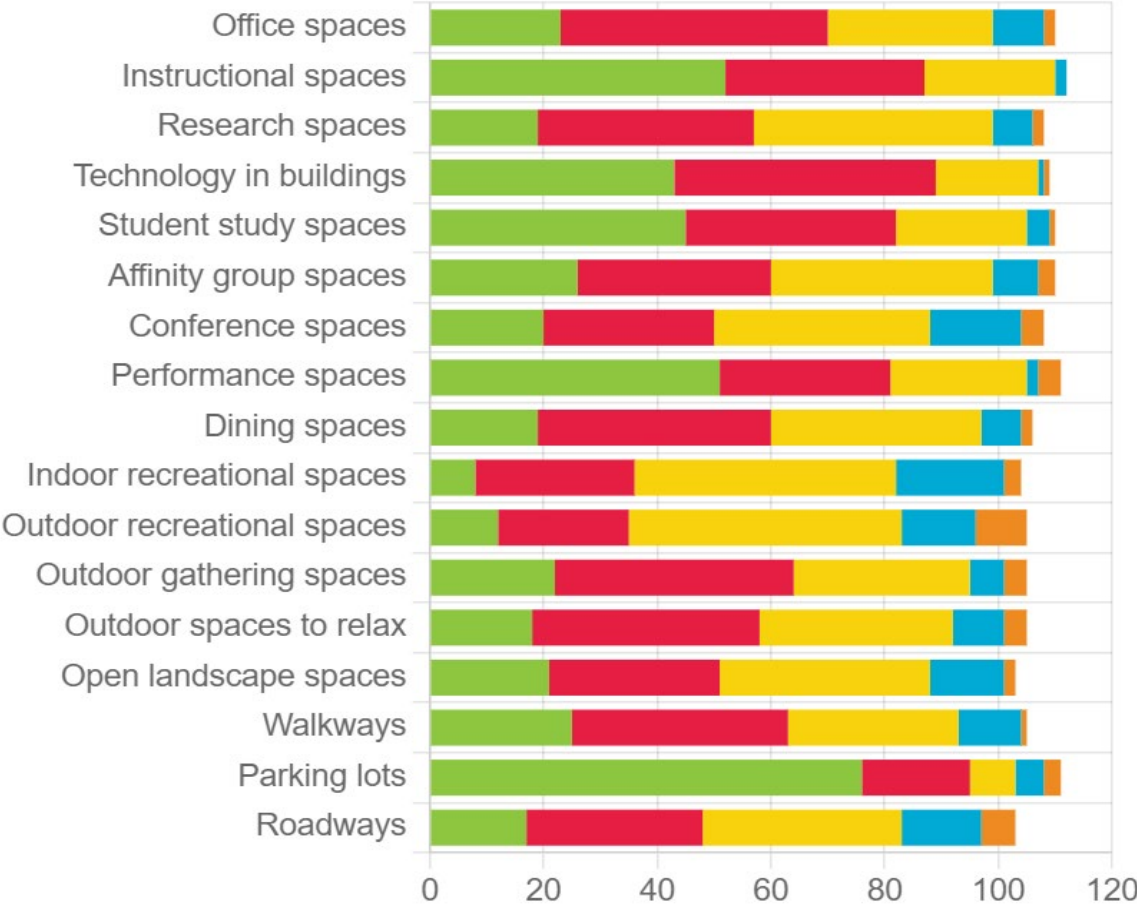
