- It is highly recommended that the scholarship application accompany your application for admission. Scholarships submitted after the admission deadlines will be considered as funds are available.

### **Please complete the following:**

1. Students should present an original portfolio of their art work: We recommend 20 slides or digital images which show at least 10 different examples of work. The quality of your slides is important; they should be well lit and fit well into the slide format. Images may be submitted on a CD. The portfolio images should be submitted in jpg or tif format.
2. Students are urged to present work that demonstrates their ability to work from life (still life, figure, landscape, etc.) as well as examples of variety in media.
3. On a separate sheet of paper answer:
  - What media do you use?
  - In your experience, how does working from life differ from copying other images?
  - What art historical precedents or contemporary artists' work are you interested in, and why?
  - Describe your most successful piece or series. Explain the initial concept, your process, and how/if the process affected the concept.
  - List any exhibitions or honors related to your work.

## 2010 Durand Art Scholarship

### **Renewal Requirements:**

- Recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 and adhere to the participation requirements of the department.
- In the spring semester of each year, recipients must submit a scholarship renewal application to the department chairperson for approval.
- Forester Scholarships are renewable for up to four years for first-year students and on a pro-rated basis for transfer students.
- Enroll in a class in the Art Department or present a portfolio of extracurricular art work made during the academic year; **AND**
- Attend at least two exhibition openings at the Sonnenschein Gallery each semester; **AND**
- Fulfill three of the following:
  - Be an active participant in the Art Club (officer or devote a minimum number of hours).
  - Assist the gallery director in the installation of an exhibit.
  - Curate an exhibition of art from the College collection or elsewhere.
  - Have current work accepted in the Lake Forest College Student Art Show (spring only).
  - Submit artwork to Tusitala or Collage (Lake Forest College literary magazines) or other College publications.
  - Complete an internship for art course credit.
  - Perform an art-related task to benefit the Art Department (in consultation with the chairperson).
  - Oversee digital lab.
