Renewal Requirements:

- Recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 and adhere to the participation requirements of the department.
- In the spring semester of each year, recipients must submit a scholarship renewal application to the department chairperson for approval.
- Forester Scholarships are renewable for up to four years for first-year students and on a pro-rated basis for transfer students.
- Attend Information session led by a Program Coordinator from the Gates Center for Leadership and Personal Growth at the beginning of the fall semester to review the scholarship requirements;
- Actively participate in at least one student organization;
- Complete two leadership certificates each year, for a total of eight (speakers, workshops, training sessions);
- Notify the scholarship advisor via email of your attendance at a program within one week of completing the event.
