# 2010 Reid Music Scholarship

## Audition Information

- The audition judges are faculty of the Lake Forest College Department of Music
- An on-campus audition is preferred. Please provide three dates and times when you can visit campus. If not possible, a CD , DVD, or tape may be sent for a Reid Music Scholarship. We cannot accept recordings of ensemble performances (with the exception of certain concerto performance; consult the Department Chair for details).
- Be prepared to play one or two pieces up to five minutes total which best represent your tone quality, intonation, and musicality. Virtuosi excerpts are not necessary. Label the music with your name. Please bring two additional copies to your audition. Plan to arrive well before the audition to allow for tuning and warm-up. In certain cases, students will be required to sightread.
- Students interested in musical theater may wish to consider the Hixon Theater Scholarship instead of the Reid Music Scholarship.
- The repertoire suggestions that follow provide a guide to the selection of literature for your audition. It is important to select music that displays your talents. You are encouraged to discuss your selections with your instructor. Be prepared to sightread.
- *Instrumental* – Two contrasting selections from a concerto, sonata, suite or any other significant solo work with or without or without accompaniment from the Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or Twentieth Century periods. (Percussion: contact the Music Department for instrument availability.)
- *Voice* – Two contrasting selections, preferably with one in a language other than English.
- You have the option of auditioning in a second instrument, for which additional audition time will be scheduled.
- Reid Music Scholarship recipients will be assigned to one of the following Lake Forest College ensembles:
  - Chorus, Chamber Orchestra, Jazz Ensemble, Concert Band, Flute Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble, or Experimental Music Group. Pianists will be assigned duties in the Music Department at the discretion of the Department Chair.
- If your piece requires accompaniment, a copy of the music must be received no later than two weeks before the date of your audition (faxed copies are not acceptable).

## Renewal Requirements:

- All recipients must participate in an ensemble.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 and adhere to the participation requirements of the department.
- In the spring semester of each year, recipients must submit a scholarship renewal application to the department chairperson for approval.
- Forester Scholarships are renewable for up to four years for first-year students and on a pro-rated basis for transfer students.
- Renewal decisions are made by the department chairperson in consultation with the ensemble director.
- Please note that any changes to the terms of your scholarship must be approved ahead of time by the chair of the Department of Music.
