

Advanced Placement Credit

Advanced Placement work is awarded Lake Forest College course credit as listed below for the tests and scores noted (e.g. A score of 4 on the AP Chemistry exam receives credit for CHEM 110). Only scores of 4 and 5 receive credit, although some departments will award credit for a score of 3. AP credits will be listed on your permanent record and may be used to meet your GEC requirements. In some cases, AP courses may meet your major requirements. Please call the Office of the Registrar to discuss possible credit granted for International Baccalaureate exams. Credit is not given for CLEP exams.
