The rules for IR Elective Courses for all IR majors:

- (1) At least five elective courses from any three Fields.
- (2) No more than three courses from any single Field.
- (3) Two of the five courses must be comparative (+).
- (4) At least three of the five courses must be at the 300-level.
- (5) Only one course credit for Field 5 counts toward the IR major.
- (6) Only IR Electives are subject to double counting, and only two can be so counted.
