1. Please express your **interests** in art at Lake Forest College:
  - What art and/or art history courses might you like to take during your time at the College, and why?
  - What would you like to learn more about?
  - What extra-curricular art-related activities might you like to be involved with at the College?
  - What, if any, job or career options can you imagine for yourself related to the arts?
2. Present an original **portfolio** of your artwork. We recommend 20 images that show at least 10 different examples of work. The images may be presented in 35 mm slide format, or in digital format on a CD, a flash drive, or a web gallery. Images may not be submitted by email attachment. The quality of your images is important; they should be well lit, in focus, and fit well into the format of presentation to best document your artwork. You are urged to present work that demonstrates your ability to work directly from life (still-life, figure, landscape, etc.) rather than from photographs. You are also encouraged to present examples of work from a variety of different media, if available.
3. Please submit an **image list** with your portfolio submission. This can be a word document or a pdf, and should give as much specific information as possible about each artwork, including title, dimensions, media, and year completed. The sequence of the images in the image list must be numbered and in exactly the same order in which the images appear in the portfolio.
4. Please describe your **abilities and experiences** in art:
  - What media do you use?
  - In your experience, how is working directly from life different from copying other images, including photographs?
  - What art historical precedents, or contemporary art are you interested in, and why? Describe your most successful piece or series of art. Explain your initial concept or inspiration, your process, and how the process affected the final outcome.
  - Finally, note any exhibitions or honors related to your artwork.
