He has more than half a dozen books to his credit, including several young adult novels. He has taught writing and communications courses at the University of Illinois-Chicago, DePaul, Lake Forest College, and Arizona State's University's MFA program. An enthusiast for seeing the world and doing his bit to make it better, Mike taught Communications at Xiamen University in China, and travels frequently to Tanzania to volunteer his skills helping a school for special needs children maintain and improve its web communications.
