

2+2+2 Program with Associates degree at CLC, BA degree from LFC and a pre-licensure MSN degree from RFUMS, in six years.

Option I: All Nursing Pre-requisites taken at CLC

- Student would have completed five LFC FFC distribution requirements:
Creative and Performing arts (CP), Humanities (H), Natural sciences (NS), Quantitative reasoning (QR), Social Sciences (SS)
- Student would have completed the two HPP seminars in Years I and II while at CLC
- Student would have completed HPP Nursing Keystone Project summer before starting at LFC
- Student would have completed HPP Science/Quantitative core (because they would have completed Nursing pre-requisites)

Notes:

4. *HPP Keystone Nursing Project: All pre-nursing students will earn an additional 0.5 LFC credit for a summer keystone HPP project the summer before they start. **This will satisfy FFC: Experiential (E)**
5. Transfer credits are awarded as follows: 6 RFUMS quarter credits = 1 LFC course credit.
