³ The rate as of September 2021, subject to change. All students must be covered by a U.S. health insurance plan. Students without insurance are billed for the College’s plan. Full-year coverage runs from August 2022 to August 2023. Single-semester coverage (January to August) currently estimated at \$1250) is available for those transferring to the College mid-year.
