
Transfer to Lake Forest College



Lake Forest College supports the academic growth and personal success of all our students. Our transfer inclusive campus community provides the personal attention you need to find success, while offering opportunities and resources often associated with much larger institutions.

Lake Forest College is located 30 miles north of Chicago in the historic North Shore community of Lake Forest, Illinois. The beautiful 107-acre campus is within walking distance to the train to Chicago and the shore of Lake Michigan.

You will have access to top professors, alumni, internships, and research. Classes are small—the average class size is 19—and professors do all the teaching and advising. Internship opportunities are widely available and 96% of recent graduates had jobs, grad school, or other opportunities lined up within six to nine months of graduation.

Transfer to Lake Forest College

TRANSFERRING CREDITS IS EASY

You may transfer up to a maximum of two years of college coursework. If you are a recipient of an associate of arts (AA) degree, associate of science degree (AS), or have earned 60 hours of transferable credit hours from an accredited community college, you may be granted full junior standing. Credit is also given for Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate examinations.

CAREER PREPARATION AND INTERNSHIPS

Developing career goals—and a plan of action to achieve them—is a central part of a Lake Forest education. Students may pursue up to 3 for-credit internships, which are abundant in the Chicago area. The Career Advancement Center offers exceptional career counseling as well as a host of networking opportunities with alumni and employers. In fact, we were named #9 Best Schools for Internships and #12 for Best Alumni Network (Princeton Review).

SCHOLARSHIPS AND AFFORDABILITY

The College offers generous financial aid packages for all admitted transfer students, including international students. Students may qualify for up to \$30,000 per year in scholarships. Lake Forest College offers generous scholarships to honor transfer students who have distinguished themselves through academic achievement:

- Our **Forester Flagship Program** offers qualified in-state students up to 100% of the College's tuition covered in grants and scholarships
- Merit-based scholarship awards up to \$30,000
- Guaranteed \$25,000 Phi Theta Kappa scholarships (\$30,000 for 3.75+ GPA)
- International students receive up to \$36,000
- Fine arts scholarships in art, music, theater
- Generous need-based financial aid, including grants, are also available
- \$2,000 annual visit grant awarded to students who take part in an in-person or virtual visit
