 - Kim Davis shared updates regarding the proposed recommendations for Inclusive Excellence, including suggestions related to its renaming, structure, and institutional positioning. These recommendations have been submitted to Interim President Krebs and are currently under discussion at the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) level. Kim Davis hopes to share further updates at the next PCIE meeting.
 - An update was also provided on the Associate Dean for Inclusive Excellence search. While oncampus interviews have concluded, candidates raised significant questions about the position's scope, funding, and reporting structure—questions for which the campus did not yet have clear answers. As a result, the SLT has paused the search rather than extend an offer now. It was emphasized that the institution remains committed to filling the role, but further clarification is needed before moving forward. Additional discussion confirmed that the Council will continue in some form next year, with its future composition still under consideration.
