

Panopto: Setup and Installation

Panopto is a great way to easily create and share videos in you class. Use this guide to add the Panopto block to your Moodle pages and get ready to record your video.

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Viewing and Searching Videos


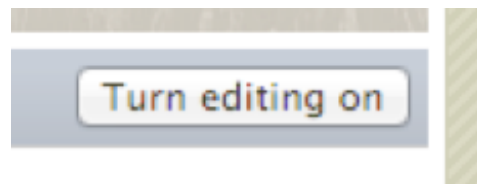
Go to <http://lakeforestcollege.hosted.panopto.com> and log in using your Moodle user name and password. View and search on any of the available videos.


Add Panopto to your Moodle Course Page

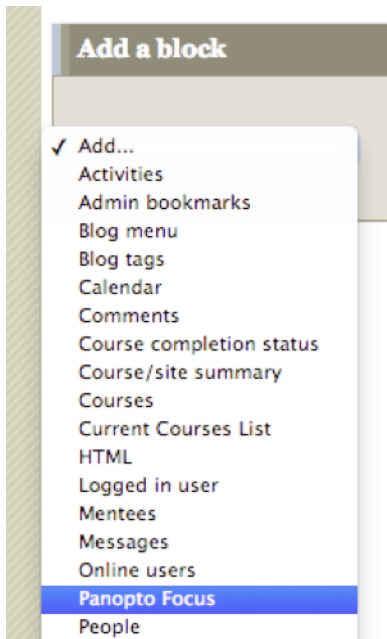
When you add Panopto to your Moodle page, a folder is created on Panopto for your course. Instructors are automatically designated as movie creators for the class, and only students enrolled in the course have viewing permissions.

Steps:

1. Sign in to Moodle. Navigate to your course and click the “Turn editing on” button at the top right.

2. Go to “Add a block” and choose “Panopto Focus.” Clicking the edit icon  to configure Panopto Focus.



On the configuration page, choose “Add this course to Panopto.”

Select the Panopto Focus course to display in this block.

Add this course to Panopto (re-add to sync user lists)

Moodle will display the course name, instructor, students, and a message that your course was successfully provisioned to Panopto. Click “Back to config.”

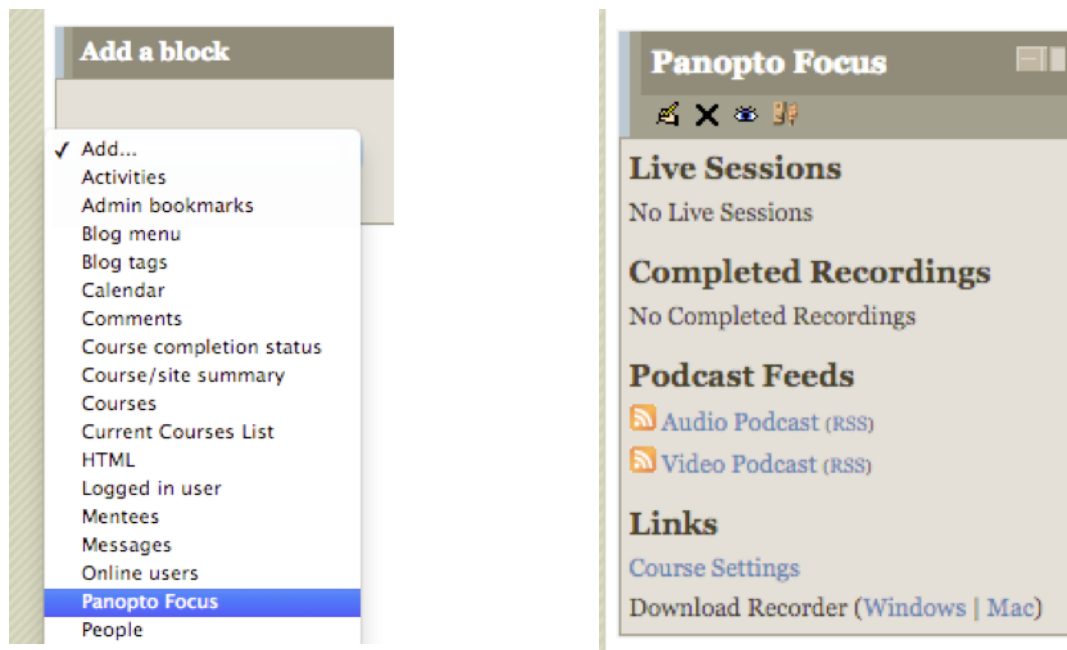

Downloading and Using Panopto Recorder

Panopto will let you record from your computer's screen, microphone, and video camera, in any combination. If you don't have a camera in your computer, inexpensive USB cameras work well and are easy to set up.

Installation

To install Panopto Recorder, go to the Panopto Focus block on your Moodle page, select "Download Recorder" and choose your system, Windows or Mac.



Download the program through your web browser, locate PanoptoRecorder.exe (Windows) or Panopto Recorder.pkg (Mac), and follow the installation prompts.

Recording with Mobile Devices

Panopto is also available for iOS devices in the [iTunes App Store](#). [Panopto Mobile for Android is available in the Play Store](#) for Android tablets and smartphones running Android version 4.0 and above (currently versions Ice Cream Sandwich, Jelly Bean, and KitKat). The app is also available in the [Amazon Kindle store](#) for Amazon Kindle Fire users. Sign in to our Panopto site, <http://lakeforestcollege.hosted.panopto.com>, with your Moodle user name and password.

Panopto Mobile will let you view any available video, and download for later viewing. You can use your device's video camera and microphone to record movies and upload them as well.
