

CHECKLIST FOR PHILOSOPHY MAJORS

A minimum of 9 credits are required for a Philosophy major.

1. Core Courses*:
Philosophy 156: Logic and Styles of Argument
Three of the following five courses: Philosophy 290: Ancient Greek Philosophy Philosophy 291: Descartes to Kant Philosophy 320: Back to the Things Themselves: Husserl, Heidegger, and Derrida Philosophy 322: Hegel to Nietzsche Philosophy 355: Wittgenstein and the Analytic Tradition
Philosophy 305: Comparative Philosophy: East and West Philosophy 325: Major Ethical Theories
2. Electives:
At least 2 additional Philosophy courses:

3. Senior Studies:
 The Senior Studies Requirement can be fulfilled in any of the following ways: Senior Seminar Independent Research Project Senior Thesis
*Students who would like to focus more exclusively on a particular area of philosophy may (in consultation with their advisor and with the approval of the chair) substitute up to two different Philosophy courses for any of the Core Courses. Students can focus, for example, on (1) ethics, political philosophy, or social justice, (2) philosophy across cultures, or (3) metaphysics and philosophy of mind.
